

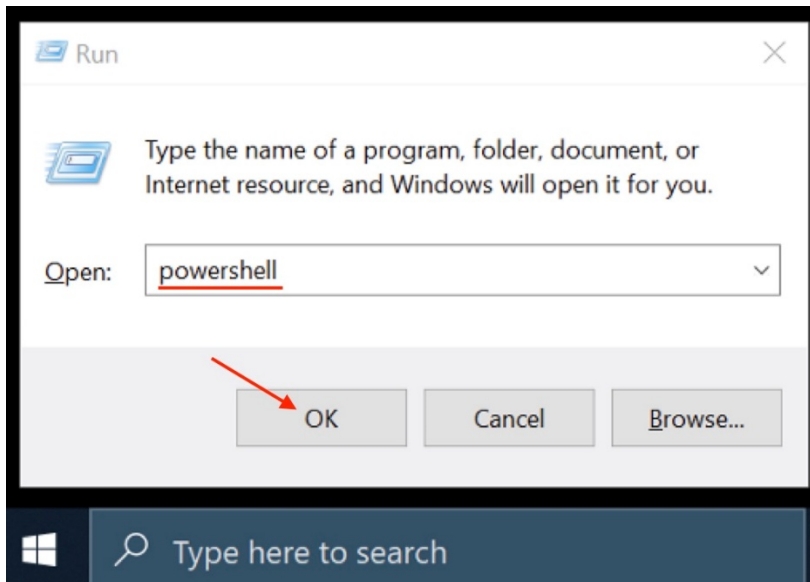

Determining Thunderbolt Controller Identifier in a Windows PC

The following Powershell command will show the type of Thunderbolt controller in a Windows PC. Press [Windows logo] key and then the [R] key to open a Run prompt.

Type
Powershell
and click OK.



Type
`Get-PnpDevice -FriendlyName *Thunder*`
and hit Enter.

The 4 characters at the end of the FriendlyName is the Thunderbolt host identifier.

```
Status      Class      FriendlyName
-----
Unknown     System     Thunderbolt(TM) Controller - 15D9
```

In this example, 15D9 identifies Thunderbolt 3 Alpine Ridge (see table below).

Thunderbolt host identifiers:

Thunderbolt 4 (three downstream Thunderbolt 4 ports)

- 1137 Maple Ridge
- 9A1B, 9A1D, 9A1F or 9A21 Tiger Lake

Thunderbolt 3 (three downstream Thunderbolt 4 ports)

- 15E8 or 15EB Titan Ridge
- 8A0D or 8A17 Ice Lake

Thunderbolt 3 (one downstream Thunderbolt 3 port + two USB 3 ports)

- 1575, 1577, 15BF, 15D2 or 15D9 Alpine Ridge
